We are now recruiting attorneys for our **Fourth Annual STREET LAW SPOKANE!**

**What is Street Law?** Street Law provides a team of three volunteer attorneys dispensing free legal advice and information in a public venue to anyone that asks. Street Law is based on a similar program started in Bellingham, WA years ago. The Center for Justice and the Spokane County Bar Volunteer Lawyer Program have teamed up to support **STREET LAW SPOKANE** again this summer.

**How does it work?** Every Saturday afternoon from May 24th through August 30<sup>th</sup>, (except for June 28<sup>th</sup>, Hoopfest weekend) we need a team of three attorneys and a legal assistant to be at Riverfront Park to provide free legal information and referrals to our community. Anyone passing by may utilize this free service. From dissolutions to landlord/tenant, consumer protection to debt collection, you will have the opportunity to flex your legal brain to help people from all over the Spokane area.

**Why would you want to do this?** Because it's rewarding, needed and fun! Fun? Yes! The STREET LAW SPOKANE program is so popular with the attorneys that they are working on a year-round program. Street Law is an opportunity for the Spokane legal community to work side-by-side with your colleagues to visibly provide access to justice. The need for pro bono legal service is greater than ever. **Besides, all Street Law attorneys will receive a snazzy Street Law T-shirt!**

**Don't think you will know the answers?** If you passed the Bar Exam, you should be able to spot the issue and point a person in the right direction. By answering a simple legal question or making an appropriate referral, you make a tremendous difference in the lives of the people who seek out your help. Street Law attorney teams will be comprised to provide a wide range of expertise. Prior to your Street Law date, you will receive a Street Law notebook that contains the answers to commonly asked questions and appropriate referral information. On-site you will be equipped with a "portable law office" with sample pleadings, brochures and office supplies. **In addition, you are invited to a free STREET LAW CLE on May 30 from 8:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at Gonzaga School of Law, Room 314.**
